Handmade in Britain is pleased to present **Handmade Oxford – The International Contemporary Arts Festival, 27 – 30 June 2019, at Waterperry Gardens**, previously the home of internationally-renowned **Art in Action** for 40 years (1977 – 2016). The festival will take place across a series of marquees on the lawns in front of Waterperry House, complemented by large-scale outdoor sculptures installed throughout the gardens and open-air evening theatre the venue's amphitheatre.

Working in collaboration with principle event partners **Waterperry Gardens** and the **Ashmolean Museum**, Handmade in Britain offers visitors the opportunity to meet, browse and shop directly from **over 250 exhibitors** working across **craft, fine art, sculpture, artisan food** and more, while enjoying the beautiful gardens and packed programme of **workshops, demonstrations** and **talks**.

Handmade in Britain is delighted to present a special **Slow Food and Slow Living** section within the festival. Curated by **Rhythms by Design**, this will highlight design and food that reflect the guiding principles of **“Good, Clean and Fair”** – a framework about going away from “fast food architecture” and instead stripping back design to its essence by re-focusing on **craftsmanship, quality, open source, enhanced wellbeing** and **timeless design**. The Slow movement is all about a mindful approach to living well. It's about savouring the hours and minutes rather than just counting them, so if you must hurry, then hurry slowly.

Innovative new designers will showcase their work alongside **established exhibitors**. Visitors are invited to discover **emerging talents** as part of various groups, organisations and guilds from across the country, including **Arts Thread** and **Making Goode**. The festival will also present the **fifteen finalists** selected as a result of Handmade in Britain's international arts competition hosted in conjunction with **Ashmolean Museum** and **Zealous**, the online submissions platform which unites the creative industry.
