- Nearest railway stations: Haddenham & Thames Parkway / Radley / Oxford
- Adult Combined One-Day Ticket (valid on any single day of festival between Thursday - Sunday) is £15 + booking fee until 31 March 2020 / £17 + booking fee from 1 April 2020 / £20 on the door
- Adult Combined Two-Day ticket (valid any two days of the festival between Thursday - Sunday) is £23 + booking fee until 31 March 2020 / £26 + booking fee from 1 April 2020 / £30 on the door
- Adult Combined Four-Day Ticket (valid Thursday - Sunday inclusive) is £32 + booking fee until 31 March 2020 / £35 + booking fee from 1 April 2020 / £40 on the door
- Concession tickets available to Senior Citizens (60 and over), Students, Ages 17 –18, Registered Unemployed, and disabled people (with free entry for one carer)
